

ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY “TRANSITIONS”

A number of items are not accepted by “Transitions”, either because they fall under Health Canada's *Hazardous Products Act* and cannot legally be sold or given away by the store or because they pose health or safety concerns.

- ◆ **Children's sleepwear in sized up to 14x
(excepting sleepwear designed for infants up to 7 kg.)**
Nightgowns, nightshirts, dressing gowns, bathrobes, house coats, robes pyjamas, baby doll pyjamas.
- ◆ **Children's sleepwear not meeting flammability standards. This includes:**
100% cotton, acrylic or acetate, or blends of these fibres
Any sleepwear that are missing labels or the labels cannot be read due to fading cannot be sold or given away as the fabric cannot be verified
- ◆ **Baby gates**
- ◆ **Baby mattresses, pillows and bumper pads**
- ◆ **Baby walkers**
- ◆ **Carriages and strollers**
- ◆ **Car seats**
- ◆ **Cosmetics and cosmetic bags**
- ◆ **Combs, curlers, hairbrushes**
- ◆ **Cribs and cradles**
- ◆ **High chairs and booster seats**
- ◆ **Children's jewellery**
- ◆ **Lawn darts**
- ◆ **Playpens**
- ◆ **Plug-in appliances (e.g. Kitchenware, vacuums, small appliances, etc.)**
- ◆ **Protective sports equipment (helmets, face protectors, goggles, etc.)**
- ◆ **Some sports equipment (e.g. Skateboards, pellet guns, etc.)**
- ◆ **Stuffed toys**
- ◆ **Toiletries**
- ◆ **Toys and games**
- ◆ **Toy boxes**
